Learning Activities: Small Group Activity

Essential Question(s): How can we use electronic resources to learn about Black History Month? What kinds of electronic equipment did African Americans invent? How has the person your group was assigned impacted the world?

SWBAT: Students will be able to use the World Wide Web and Macbooks to locate and record information about African American Individuals who made great contributions to the world.

Activating Strategy: Students will be broken into groups of 2. Each group will be assigned an African American Individual. Students will use the browser Google chrome to research the individual and record information about them.

Teaching Strategy: The instructor will facilitate a discussion about Black History Month. This discussion will include a video of various facts about black history and historical figures.
